**RESPONSIBILITY:** GH is responsible to you for arranging all included transportation, accommodations and other services. However, in the absence of negligence on its part, GH is not responsible for personal injury, property damage, or any other loss, claim or damage arising out of or related to goods or services offered or included. GH is not responsible for personal injury, property damage or any other loss, claim or damage related to or arising out of, in whole or in part, acts of God, weather, labor strife, government actions, mechanical breakdowns, war-like acts, terrorist activities or other causes reasonably beyond the respective control of GH. GH is not responsible for incidental or consequential losses or damages.

**PAYMENT:** A deposit in the amount shown on the reservation form and a signed agreement for each person is required to secure reservations. Final payment is due as shown on the reservation form. If space is fully booked, your payment will be returned or, with your authorization, your name placed on a waiting list. ALL CHECKS AND MONEY ORDERS ARE TO BE MADE PAYABLE AS INDICATED ON THE RESERVATION FORM. CONFIRMATION IS SUBJECT TO RECEIPT BY GH OF DEPOSIT AND A SIGNED AGREEMENT.

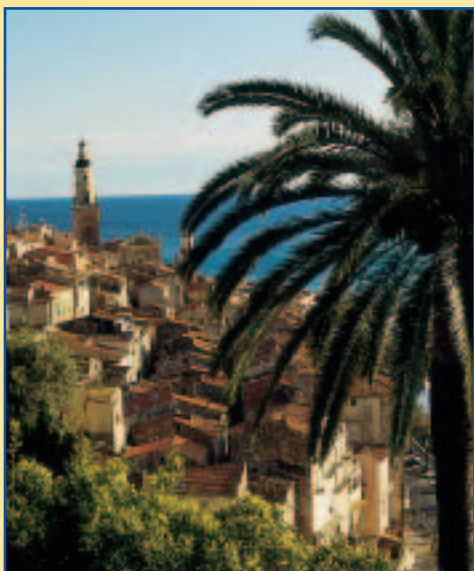

Continue to Arles, a charming city noted for its wealth of Roman remains. Its Roman theater and well-preserved amphitheater are just two of its numerous monuments listed as UNESCO World Heritage monuments. Overnight in Arles.

**Day 2** Visit an engineering masterpiece, the magnificent Pont du Gard. Part of an aqueduct built around 19 BC, this amazing two-tiered bridge is 158 feet high, the highest bridge the Romans ever built. Continue to well-preserved Avignon, surrounded by massive ramparts, a delight to explore. Visit the spectacular Papal Palace, the 14th century seat of the Papal Court and one of the most imposing medieval monuments in Europe, as well as the famous 12th century bridge, Pont St-Bénézet. Return to your hotel on the French Riviera.

### CANNES AND ST-PAUL-DE-VENTE

World renowned for its famous film festival, Cannes is the most fashionable and chic resort on the Riviera. Soak up the rich and sophisticated atmosphere of the city as you explore the charming old quarter, laced with picturesque narrow streets and delightful cafes, or stroll the elegant palm-lined boulevard de la Croisette. See the Palais des Festivals, where the stars gather each spring for the annual film festival, before continuing to medieval St-Paul-de-Vence. Built on a rocky outcrop and surrounded by ramparts, it is one of the most scenic and beautiful villages in Provence.

### MONTE CARLO, MONACO

Located on a narrow strip of Mediterranean coastline that forms the tiny Principality of Monaco, glamorous Monte Carlo is part sophisticated capital city and part sun-kissed resort. Marvel at the lavish Casino, the 13th century Prince's Palace and the elegant Hotel de Paris. Add the magnificent yacht-filled harbor and numerous stylish shops to the famous and alluring attractions this small but wealthy enclave has to offer.

### ST-TROPEZ AND PORT GRIMAUD

Once a picturesque fishing village, St-Tropez is now a world famous resort, frequented by impressionist artists such as Matisse and popularized by Brigitte Bardot in the 1950s. Today its harbor is filled with luxury yachts and is lined with delightful terrace cafes. Not to be missed is the OldTown with its narrow streets, delightful shops and chic boutiques. Continue to Port Grimaud, a lovely village affectionately known as Little Venice, because of its many canals and waterways.
