WOMEN OF WAYNE INCENTIVE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM FOR WSU PART-TIME WOMEN STUDENTS

Eligibility:

The Women of Wayne Incentive Scholarship Program for Part-Time Students was established to recognize scholastic achievement, to encourage continued progress, and to provide assistance to women students in financing their education at Wayne State University.

Applications will be accepted from currently enrolled part-time women students of Wayne State University who have previously had their college education interrupted and who are not recipients of any other scholarships, grants, or loans. Recipients will be selected on the basis of scholastic achievement, desirable qualities of character and leadership, and financial need.

FEDERATION OF WOMEN'S CLUBS OF METROPOLITAN DETROIT SCHOLARSHIP FOR WSU WOMEN STUDENTS

Eligibility:

The Federation of Women's Clubs of Metropolitan Detroit Scholarship is for a full or part-time WSU woman student.

Applications will be accepted from currently enrolled women students of Wayne State University who have previously had their college education interrupted. The recipient will be selected on the basis of scholastic achievement, desirable qualities of character and leadership, and financial need.

AWARD CRITERIA AND PROCEDURES FOR THESE SCHOLARSHIPS

1. Both of the above scholarships are for tuition only and are for only the semester for which the scholarship is awarded. Awards may not be used for subsequent semesters but award recipients may submit another application for consideration.
2. Recipients will be recommended to the Office of Scholarships and Financial Aid by the Women of Wayne Scholarship Committee and selected in accordance with the general policies and practices in effect for scholarships at the university.
3. The amount of money available in the accounts and the individual needs of the qualified applicants will determine the number and the amount of the scholarship awards.
4. The Office of Scholarships and Financial Aid will disburse the awards according to regular University procedures.
5. The Office of Scholarships and Financial Aid may reduce the amount of an award when the recipient registers for fewer credits than stipulated in the award. However, authorization by Women of Wayne's representative is required to increase awards.

If at any time the university policies and procedures in effect for the administration of scholarships and funds are changed, these provisions are automatically modified to conform.
